New Tariffs for Water Bills

Southern Water have recently launched their new Social Tariff which they have branded "Essentials Tariff" to help and support customers on a low income who face high water bills for whatever reason.

Also, anybody who is in receipt of Pension Credit is now eligible for an automatic 20% discount.

Where their charges represent 3% or more of your housing income (after housing costs) you may be eligible for a discount on your future bills. They will match your payments if you qualify.

If you're on a meter or have large bills due to medical conditions or a large family they can help. There is also help for those receiving means tested benefits.

This service will be available to our general needs tenants who hold a tenancy with the 'right to exchange' (generally this will be secure or assured tenancies).

How Are We Doing?

The Housing Services team has a number of areas they are measured on to ensure we are providing a good service to tenants.

Boiler servicing

An important target is making sure everyone who has a boiler has it serviced once a year for safety.

This year we have achieved 100% success in reaching this goal. Don't forget if you have a gas boiler you must let us check it once a year.

Rent collection

Collecting rent is vital to BHT to ensure we can repair and improve our stock.

We work very closely with anyone who falls into arrears to maximise their income and help them get their rent account up to date. Last year we had arrears of only 1.7% which is very good performance compared to other social landlords. If you do get into any difficulties paying your rent or service charges please contact us, we are here to help.

Letting

Letting our homes quickly is essential so we can house the maximum number of people and minimise the rent loss on empty properties.

Our target is a 24 day turnaround and we are currently achieving 22 days which is good but we will be working to improve it.

Repairs

You always tell us that repairs are the most important area for us to get right.

We have been working hard to make improvements in this area. Between January and March we completed 358 jobs in total.

Later this year we will be holding a repairs focus group to hear your ideas on how we can improve this service. Progress is being made but we look forward to making further improvements during course of the year.

Janny's Tips: How to Avoid Scams

Scams are schemes to con you out of your money.

One scam currently hitting people is scam letting. People are drawn to properties advertised as private and they are met by a person who poses as the landlord. Pressure is put on the individual once they have seen the property to give a deposit and a month's rent straight away. They then find later that both the recipient and money vanish into thin air.

To avoid this, there is a simple check that can be made. It takes minutes and can be accessed on your mobile if you have internet access for just £3! This HM Land Registry website holds records about most property or land sold in England or Wales and will tell you exactly who owns the property. Ask to see I.D. of the person showing you round/asking for a deposit.

Another scam you may have heard about in the news is a type of malicious software known as ransomware. Ransomware makes your data or systems unusable until the victim makes a payment. There are three main things you should do to protect yourself:

- 1. Update Windows
- 2. Run antivirus software
- 3. Keep a safe backup of your important files

N.B. If you are still using Windows XP your computer would be at serious risk as this is no longer supported by anti virus updates.
