


Our contractors will have the contact numbers for BHT Senior Managers on call over the holiday period for any unforeseen emergencies.

We would recommend that tenants leave a spare key with a family member or close friend just in case they get locked out, as it will not be possible to get spare keys over Christmas and New Year, when BHT offices are closed.

Are you passionate about your garden? Would you like to feed back and help improve how it's maintained by our contractors?

We now have seven Green Inspectors representing Blake Court, Walton Bank, The Causeway and Shanklin Court.

We are looking for more tenants across BHT's properties in Brighton and Hastings to get involved. The role will involve carrying out regular inspections to rate and comment on different elements of the gardening such as grass cutting, shrub beds, hedges, paved areas and weeds after the contractors have visited, then emailing/sending in the post the completed form back, once completed.

A full induction and training for the role will be provided. Your rating and feedback will then be used to help improve the gardening service received from our contractors.

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Winter's Here. Are You Worrying About Your Fuel Bills?

BHT knows keeping warm over the winter is a drain on hard-pushed finances whether you use gas or electricity.

Fuel bills can end up taking a large chunk out of your income but **National Energy Action** (a charity working to end fuel poverty) have put together some money-saving tips:



READ YOUR METER

Read your meter regularly to check how much you are using or if your prepayment meter is still in credit.

Meters are read from left to right. Unsure? Pop into your local office and we'll explain.



CHECK YOUR BILLS

If your bill is showing 'E' after the units used, your utility company has estimated your reading.

Contact them with the actual reading or you may receive a much larger bill than you were expecting.



IN DEBT? CONTACT YOUR SUPPLIER

Struggling to get on top of it? Speak to your supplier now. If they know there's a problem they can work with you to find a solution.

Ask to set up a payment plan but be realistic about what you can afford to repay. Suppliers must follow strict rules when working with people in debt. You don't want to leave yourself short for other essential bills.

Some suppliers can assist with grants or assistance payments if you are in exceptional hardship. This depends on the supplier and individual but it's always worth asking.

SWITCH SUPPLIER

You may save money by switching supplier.

You can do this at price comparison sites over the internet and make sure that the supplier offers you any discounts you may be entitled to such as the Warm Home Discount, which offers a saving of £140 on electricity bills for the winter period 2017-18. Those who receive the Guarantee Credit element of Pension Credit are eligible, as are some other low-income and vulnerable households. You can also ask for any special tariffs you need such as Economy 7 or Economy 10.

If you have a smart meter you should still be able to switch but you may lose the 'smart' functions of your meter.



Our new Service Charter explains everything

'Your Service Charter' is a leaflet recently produced by BHT to explain what you can expect from us as a housing association, as well as outlining what your responsibilities are to BHT as a tenant.

The leaflet covers topics ranging from the condition of your property, repairs, your rent account, getting involved with BHT and how to make a complaint if necessary.

Look out for the charter leaflet which will be sent out to all tenants in the post over the next few weeks.

CHANGING HOW YOU USE YOUR GAS AND ELECTRICITY

Don't leave your heating or water on Constant. Set it for those times of the day when you may need it most like morning and evening. Unsure? Then give us a call.

Guidelines for the living room is 21° C and other rooms 18° C, unless you have a long term disability, young children or are an older person and feel you need the extra heat. However, you should avoid overheating your rooms.

- close your curtains and doors at night to keep warmth in
- turn off lights and appliances you aren't using and use energy saving bulbs if possible

In the kitchen:

- put a lid on pans when boiling liquids as this saves energy and reduces condensation
- if you have a washing machine use the 30°C setting to save money

In the bathroom:

- showers are still much more economical than baths
- to cut down on condensation and mould open the nearest window for a while to let out any steam

Three Important Areas

In last year's tenants' survey, three topics were identified as key areas of service improvement.

Following this, we held a series of focus groups in October and November on different topics where we invited tenants to come and share their views, opinions and suggestions for improvements. These included: How you would like to get involved as a tenant, what is your experience of our repairs service and what is your experience of the Complaints Procedure.

In the first focus group, ideas discussed included setting up tenants' associations or tenants' area panels, better use of noticeboards, energy fit homes, solar panels, feedback about future plans for modernisation of flats and mutual exchange within the trust.

For the repairs focus group, tenants weighed up the pros and cons of in-house handymen versus contractors. They also expressed an interest in having a tenant representative at the quarterly meetings with contractors.

In the complaints focus group, tenants suggested improvements to the wording of the Complaints Form, a reduction to the number of days it takes to respond to a complaint, and an idea for an online tracking system showing how a complaint is progressing.

Thank you to the tenants who got involved in the focus groups. Your ideas and suggestions are being reviewed and will be presented in a report early in the New Year.
