Project/Department Summary

The Phase One Project is a 52-bed supported housing project providing a high level of support to our clients. The project provides a high standard of accommodation within a grade II listed building. The accommodation is comprised of four adjoining town houses containing 43 units of half board accommodation and two pre-tenancy flats containing 9 self-catering units.

The client group is referred to the project by the Housing Options Team of Brighton and Hove City Council. All clients have high support needs and the work is focussed on providing safe, secure accommodation while addressing each resident's individual support needs and supporting clients towards move on. The project operates a harm minimisation approach that includes supporting and encouraging clients towards abstinence.

Job Summary

The post holder will be responsible to the Project Cook, assisting the cook in the day to day running of the Project's kitchen and food service. In addition to preparing and serving meals to residents the kitchen porter will assist the cook in ensuring that the food service meets all food standards and health and safety regulation. A key part of the job is the ability to work as part of a team in a fast paced and sometimes challenging environment, and at all times to provide a professional and welcoming service.

Salary

The salary is paid monthly in arrears and will be £17,355 per annum pro rata. A 5.5% employer's pension contribution is also paid. The level of this contribution is reviewed annually.

Hours of Work

The hours of work for will be 30 hours per week, working Sunday to Thursday 1:00pm to 7:00pm and 12 hours per week working Friday to Saturday 1:00pm to 7:00pm. BHT does not pay overtime but will grant "time off in lieu" when agreed by the Project Manager.

Annual Holidays

The annual leave entitlement will be 185 hours (25 working days), rising 1 day for each year of service to a maximum of 222 hours (30 days) pro rata. All public bank holidays are granted with two extra statutory days, to be taken over the Christmas period.
