Project/Department Summary

Brittany Road (Stage 1) **where this particular post will be based**, is a 9 bed high support service, taking clients aged 16 to 25 with complex needs. Southwater Rd and Milward Rd (Stage 2) are 5 bed shared houses with support being provided by a dedicated key worker. Residents will move on from these houses into more independent accommodation including its own stage 3 property at Filsham Road.

The structured life skills programme equips people to live independently. The programme includes cooking, budgeting, form filling, social skills, being a good neighbour and tenant, health and safety and DIY and is delivered at all stages within this pathway.

Job Summary

To provide support using psychologically informed, strength's based and solution focused practice to young people living in the stage 3 accommodation. To equip the residents with the skills and tools they will need to live independently.

Salary
